

COMPOUND W

Liquid Wart Remover

Salicylic Acid

Please read this leaflet carefully before using this medicine. If you have any questions or are unsure about anything, ask your doctor or pharmacist.

Active ingredient: Salicylic Acid 17% w/w.

This medicine also contains: Acetone, Industrial Methylated Spirits 99%, Pyroxylin and Castor Oil.

Compound W is available in a clear glass bottle containing 6.5 ml of clear liquid for external application.

Compound W contains salicylic acid which has keratolytic properties, which means that it softens and dissolves the areas of hard skin associated with warts and verrucas and aids their removal.

Compound W is for the treatment of common warts and verrucae. Common warts have a thick cauliflower-like surface. Verrucas occur on the sole of the foot and may be covered in hard skin.

BEFORE YOU USE THIS MEDICINE:

You should not use this medicine if you are allergic to any of the ingredients. If you are diabetic you should speak to your doctor before treating any foot condition.

Do not use this medicine on moles, birth marks, or on hairy, genital or facial warts. If in doubt ask your doctor or pharmacist.

SPECIAL WARNINGS:

Do not apply **Compound W** to healthy skin or skin which is inflamed or broken. If it comes into contact with healthy skin, wash it off immediately with plenty of water. Avoid contact with the eyes and mouth.

Not to be used on children under 6 years except under medical advice. Replace cap tightly after use.

FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY

USING THIS MEDICINE:

Adults, the elderly and children over 6:

Gently rub the hard skin from the surface of the wart with a pumice stone or emery board. Apply **Compound W** one drop at a time until the wart is covered. Allow to dry and cover with a waterproof plaster. Repeat daily with regular washing for up to twelve weeks. If the wart does not dissolve or gets worse, speak to your doctor.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Compound W may not suit everybody. If you experience any unwanted effect that is severe or lasts for more than a few days, you should tell your doctor.

STORING YOUR MEDICINE:

You should not use this medicine after the expiry date which appears on the label.

Keep all medicines out of the reach of children.
